ALUMNI ARTISTS HALL OF FAME

Statement of Purpose

Sponsored by the CDS Alumni Association, the Artists Hall of Fame recognizes members of the Carolina Day School family who have made significant contributions to the arts. The term “arts” includes, but is not limited to, music (instrumental and vocal), dance, drama, folk art, creative writing, architecture and allied fields, painting, sculpture, photography, graphic and craft arts, industrial design, set design, costume and fashion design, motion pictures, television, radio, tape and sound recording, the arts related to the presentation, performance, execution, and exhibition of such major arts forms, and the study and application of the arts to the human environment.

Members of the Artists Hall of Fame Committee

The Artists Hall of Fame Committee will consist of a minimum of seven (7) members including:

1. Current music, art, or drama teacher of Carolina Day School;
2. A current Upper School faculty member;
3. At least one Advancement Office representative; and
4. At least four at-large representatives of the Carolina Day School community selected by the Advancement Office—at least two of whom shall be alumnae/i.

All committee members will have full voting privileges concerning committee actions. The official year of the committee will be Carolina Day School’s fiscal year. The purpose of the committee is to review nominees for and select inductees into the Artists Hall of Fame.

Qualifications for the Carolina Day School Artists Hall of Fame

To be eligible for nomination, a person must have at least a five year separation from Carolina Day School and must qualify in one or more of the following categories: (Induction may be posthumous.)

1. A Carolina Day School alumnus/a who participated in Carolina Day School or its predecessor schools arts program, majored in the arts in college, or who works as a professional in the arts.
2. Former arts teachers at Carolina Day School or its predecessor schools.
3. Those who have given meritorious service or have been a loyal friend to the Carolina Day School arts program or the arts program of its predecessor schools.

Selection process and recognition

- A. Names for nominations may be submitted to the committee at any time by any one.
- B. Members of the Artists Hall of Fame Committee are excluded from being nominated during their term of service.
- C. No more than five (5) candidates may be enrolled within the first year of the Carolina Day School Alumni Artists Hall of Fame and no more than three (3) each year thereafter.
- D. Each inductee will be presented with an award plaque and a permanent plaque will be housed in the Alumni Office.
