

Middle School Supplies 2010 - 2011

Students are expected to have school supplies when school begins on Tuesday, August 24, but we encourage students not to set up their notebooks or label dividers until they meet with teachers during the first week of school. **We encourage parents to purchase recycled supplies whenever possible to support our school's emphasis on becoming a more "green" community.** *If you ordered supplies through the Parent Council's School Kidz program in the spring, note that starred (*) items will not be purchased as part of School Kidz, Inc. These items must be purchased separately by the parent.*

Supplies: All Grades

500 sheets of college-ruled loose-leaf notebook paper
3 dozen #2 pencils with erasers
one 24-pack of colored pencils
1 zipper pocket (w/ 3 holes) for pens and pencils
1 double-pocket folder (for Spanish or French)
12 Sanford Uni-Ball black gel pens

* 3-inch zippered binder with optional expanding file folder attached. *Choose a binder system that works for you.*
* bookbag or backpack **that fits into locker** (10 1/2" x 11" x 6" tall locker; bookbags are not allowed in classrooms.)

* large college-edition dictionary (for use at home)
* 1 pair tennis shoes - to be used exclusively for indoor gym use
* 1 USB memory stick (minimum 1 gb) - labeled with student name
* 2 sturdy interlocking locker shelves (coated wire, not hard plastic. Each is 12-inches in height.)
* 3 boxes of tissues (turn into advisor for class use)
* **For all Spanish students only:**
Spanish/English dictionary - to use at home
1 three-hole, one-subject, spiral notebook

Additional Sixth-Grade Supplies

6-plastic folders (2 pocket, 3-hole, no prongs/brads)
1 accordian file folder with flap (for 8 1/2 x 11 papers)
one 1-inch binder with plastic insert cover
one 3-section spiral notebook
60 sheet protectors
1 pkg. 3x3 multi-colored Post-its (200 sheets)
2 yellow and 2 other-colored highlighters
4 multi-colored dry erase board markers (chisel-tip preferred)
300 ruled notecards (3x5)
2 glue sticks
1 composition book, marble cover, black-100 sewn sheets

* calculator-inexpensive/basic arithmetic functions

Additional Seventh-Grade Supplies

6 composition book, marble cover, black-100 sewn sheets
3 two-pocket folders
12 Sanford Uni-Ball red gel pens
3 small yellow chisel-tip highlighters
600 ruled notecards (3x5)
100 sheets of graph paper (4 square/in)
2 glue sticks

* calculator-inexpensive/basic arithmetic functions
* optional - file box to hold 3x5 notecards

Additional Eighth-Grade Supplies

one 3-inch binder (without zipper for Portfolio)
four 3-hole pocket folders to fit inside zipper binder
3 highlighter pens (assorted colors)
3x3 multi-colored Post-its (200 sheets)
1 pkg. subject dividers with tabs
1 box sheet protectors (60)
300 ruled notecards (3 x 5)
100 sheets of graph paper (4 squares per inch)
1 three-hole, one subject, spiral notebook for Algebra

* scientific calculator-with square root key and exponent (y^x) key

* **A major component of 8th grade visual arts is photography. Students will be using black and white film which they may purchase, as needed, (some use more than others) throughout the year from the art teacher. Typically, students average using 3-5 rolls per year. We purchase the film in bulk and each roll costs approximately \$5.00.**
